## **About the Organizers**

Philippine Network of Food Security Programmes (PNFSP) is a national network with 25 member organizations committed to greater food security and agroecology as an alternative agricultural system and a social movement.

The Alliance for Genuine Development SOCSKSARGEN is a broad alliance opposed to developmental aggression and environmental destruction in South Cotabato, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, Davao del Sur, and General Santos City. The alliance was formed in the mid-1990s at the height of the struggle against the proposed large-scale mining, the unbridled and aggressive expansion of agri-plantations, and other environmentally destructive projects in the region by local and multinational companies. AGD is a member organization of PNFSP.

Climate Change Network for Community-based Initiatives is a national network of 16 member organizations for climate justice, environmental rights, and sustainable development.

The UP Center for Integrative and Development Studies (UP CIDS) is the policy research unit of the University of the Philippines System. The Program on Alternative Development is one of the programs at UP CIDS that aims to look at paradigms that are largely marginalized and excluded from the mainstream and surface grassroots perspectives from the margins.
